

Epitaxial, medium-speed switching diode with a low leakage current encapsulated in a small SOD323 SMD plastic package.




Fig.1 Simplified outline (SOD323) (SC-76) and symbol.






Device mounted on an FR4 printed-circuit board.

Fig.3 Forward current as a function of forward voltage.




Based on square wave currents.

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



Fig.6 Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values.




