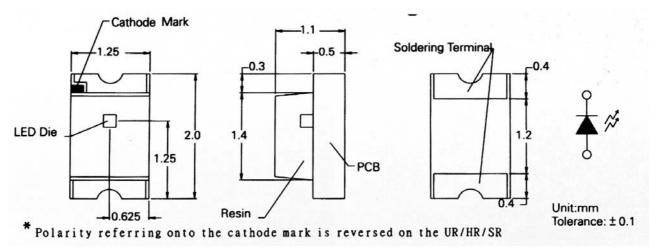
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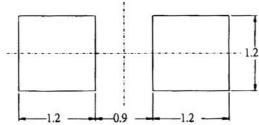

- 1. Luminous intensity is measured with a light sensor and filter combination that approximates the CIE eye-response curve.
