


Product Description

Sirenza Microdevices' SGA-4386 is a high performance SiGe HBT MMIC Amplifier. A Darlington configuration featuring 1 micron emitters provides high $F_{\rm T}$ and excellent thermal perfomance. The heterojunction increases breakdown voltage and minimizes leakage current between junctions. Cancellation of emitter junction non-linearities results in higher suppression of intermodulation products. At 850 Mhz and 45mA , the SGA-4386 typically provides +28.9 dBm output IP3, 17 dB of gain, and +15.3 dBm of 1dB compressed power using a single positive voltage supply. Only 2 DC-blocking capacitors, a bias resistor and an optional RF choke are required for operation.



Noise Figure vs. Frequency $V_p = 3.2 \text{ V}, I_p = 45 \text{ mA (Typ.)}$








Typical RF Performance Over Temperature (Bias: V_D = 3.2 V, I_D = 45 mA (Typ.))




Basic Application Circuit

Mounting Instructions

- 1. Use a large ground pad area under device pins 2 and 4 with many plated through-holes as shown.
- We recommend 1 or 2 ounce copper. Measurements for this data sheet were made on a 31 mil thick FR-4 board with 1 ounce copper on both sides.

Pin#	Function	Description
1	RF IN	RF input pin. This pin requires the use of an external DC blocking capacitor chosen for the frequency of operation.
2, 4	GND	Connection to ground. Use via holes for best performance to reduce lead inductance as close to ground leads as possible.
3	RF OUT/ BIAS	RF output and bias pin. DC voltage is present on this pin, therefore a DC blocking capacitor is necessary for proper operation.


